• Nearby Places to create the buzz -

1. <u>Sundarban National Park</u> - One of the life experience is to visit this national park. It is a delta region surrounded by the rivers, and the wilderness is a combination of beauty and an eerie vibe. Excellent place to experience the low and high tides of the sea. Also, don't forget to collect the natural honey from this place!

2. <u>Sajnekhali Watch Tower</u> - This is the prime Watchtower complex and is highly recommended for watching various rare birds like pelicans and Kingfishers. The complex gives way to Museum and also has spots where you can get the serene panoramic view of the majestic Sundarbans and chances are, that you could spot a Royal Bengal Tiger, Backwater crocodiles, deer and wild boars.

3. <u>Sudhanyakhali Watch Tower</u>- This watchtower is the place where you have the highest chances of seeing tigers. Spotted deer are very frequent and a normal view of this place.

4. <u>Dobanki Watch Tower and camp</u> - The sunset from this place is worth mentioning. The canopy walk is an experience in itself. There is a sweet water

pond where tigers often visit for consuming water. You just need to be at the right moment to spot this view.

5. *Netidhopani*- This is a watchtower where you can have a view of the ruins of Lord Shiva's 400-year-old temple. This place has a capacity of limited people and you also need permits for visiting this area.

1. Sagar Island - This is a pretty beautiful and worth exploring place. The long paved pavilion gives the impression of walking up to some important place. This is one of the most renowned holy places for Hindus, and lies on the continental shelf of the Bay of Bengal, in the Ganges Delta. Once you've visited the temple, you can relax on the beach for some time before heading back.

2. Burirdabri - One of the tourist spot in Sundarban Buffer zone. The jungle is dense, the canals are narrow and look extremely wild. The Ray Mangal river adjacent to this place is also the international border between India and

Bangladesh. The natural beauty is worth a visit, and a few pug marks are always seen over the mud.

3. Bacon Bungalow - This is a historical Bungalow and is known for the fact that Rabindranath Tagore stayed at this place. This place offers the serene beauty of the jungle and decent sightseeing.

4. Kanak- This is a not-so-popular tourist spot, but worth a visit. The shores of Kanak offer crystal clear water along with the highest chances of spotting Turtles all around.

5. Halliday island - This island is located in the southern region of the Sundarbans national park, and some rumors say that it possesses a rare retreat of the barking deer. Also, this is a place to watch exotic birds wherever your eyes rest.

6. Bonnie Camp- This is known to be a 50 feet high watchtower and is located near to the Bay of Bengal. This is a remote but prime place to watch the vast belt of the Sundarbans. It takes around 5-7 hours to reach this place from the Sundarbans National Park and is worth a stay overnight.
