


- Area: 58 m²

- This 58m2 cabin in the Andean region embodies the concept of compact living. Designed for solo travelers, couples, or couples with a child, it strategically embraces the surrounding landscape, especially a lush northern forest.
- Year: 2021 The cabin's layout is a single, open space oriented along the east-west axis, creating expansive vistas towards the forest. Each functional area within the cabin, such as the kitchen, living room, bedroom, and bathroom, features two-meter-wide openings, offering captivating views of the outdoors.

To address limited natural light due to towering trees, a skylight was introduced in the highest part of the cabin. Despite the unified space, a subtle floor variation elevates the bedroom area for added privacy. The cabin's construction primarily relies on locally sourced wood, skillfully crafted by local artisans.


Site Plan








Sectional Elevation (side)






Sectional Elevation (Front)
